Rifle Match Date: Saturday, May 24th

Location: Alliance Rifle Club, 6005 Alliance Rd NW, Malvern OH 44644

Eligibility: This match is open to all qualified shooters 14 years or older. Military personnel may enter if they comply with applicable regulations. Membership in the NRA or a CMP affiliated club is not required.

Entries: Entries may be made in writing or email in advance. Pre-registration is strongly encouraged to ensure we can provide an adequate number of E-Targets. Participants will sign a CMP eligibility affidavit and liability agreement and an ARC club liability release.

Range capacity: Range capacity for this match is 48 shooters.

Time to arrive: Front gate will be open at 7:00 AM. Arrive no later than 7:30 AM.

Registration & squadding: 7:00 to 7:30 AM at the building at the 300 yard line parking lot, with any final adjustments to be made on the firing line. Up to 4 relays may be squadded.

Time of Firing: Pits will seal at 7:45 am. Firing will begin at 8:00 am.

Rules: CMP 2025 Competition Rulebook (28th Edition) Empty chamber indicators are required.

Fees: Daily fee: \$60.00 for adults, \$30 for juniors.

Rifles/Sights Allowed: "Service Rifle" and "Match Rifle" as defined in the Current CMP Rulebook, Rule 5.1.

Challenges: A challenge fee of \$3.00 will be charged for each unsuccessful challenge made.

Food: Competitors are responsible for their own food and water. There will be no lunch break.

Awards: Rifle type, category, and classification winners will be announced/awarded based on participation.

Ammunition: Competitors must supply their own safe ammunition. No incendiary or tracer ammo is permitted.

Course of Fire: CMP Highpower Rifle Long Course (Rule 6.5.4), consisting of the 100 shot National Match Course of Fire, (20 shots Offhand, 20 shots rapid sitting, 20 shots rapid prone, and two strings of 20 shots at 600 yards prone). This will be fired as in the "CMP Cup Match" format (with sighters, and rapid fire starting from position).

Rifle Match Date: Sunday, May 25th

Location: Alliance Rifle Club, 6005 Alliance Rd NW, Malvern OH 44644

Eligibility: This match is open to all qualified shooters 14 years or older. Military personnel may enter if they comply with applicable regulations. Membership in the NRA or a CMP affiliated club is not required.

Entries: Entries may be made in writing in advance. Pre-registration is strongly encouraged to ensure we can provide an adequate number of E-Targets. Participants will sign a CMP eligibility affidavit and liability agreement and ARC club liability release. In the event there are fewer than 6 non-distinguished shooters entered, the event will NOT be conducted and all fees will be returned.

Range capacity: Range capacity for this match is 48 shooters, with priority going to Non-Distinguished Shooters.

Time to arrive: Front gate will be open at 8:00 AM. Arrive no later than 8:30 AM.

Registration, squadding, and rifle inspection: 8:00 to 8:30 AM at the building at the 300 yard line parking lot, with any final adjustments to be made on the firing line. Up to 4 relays may be squadded.

Time of Firing: Pits will seal at 8:45 am. Firing will begin at 9:00 am.

Rules: CMP 2025 Competition Rulebook (28th Edition) Empty chamber indicators are required.

Fees: Match entry fee: \$40.00

Rifles/Sights Allowed: "Service Rifle" and "Match Rifle" as defined in the Current CMP Rulebook, Rule 5.1. (Match rifles are permitted, but will not be awarded EIC Points)

Challenges: A challenge fee of \$3.00 will be charged for each unsuccessful challenge made.

Food: Competitors are responsible for their own food and water. There will be no lunch break.

Awards: Achievement Pins will be presented to competitors with a score that equals or exceeds Achievement Award Scores. Points are given to any non-distinguished shooters who place in the top 10% of non-distinguished shooters, and whose score fired equals or exceeds the EIC Minimum Credit Score (MCS) (Rule, 10.3.7). Calculations are based on rule 10.3.6. All Points are issued by the CMP.

Ammunition: Competitors must supply their own safe ammunition. No incendiary or tracer ammo is permitted.

Course of Fire: CMP Rifle Excellence in Competition Match, Rule 9.3, the Rifle National Match Course (rule 6.4 Table 4).

Time of Firing: Pits will seal at 8:45 am. Firing will begin at 9:00 am.

Rules: CMP 2025 Competition Rulebook (28th Edition) Empty chamber indicators are required.

Fees: Team entry fee: \$30.00 (A junior 2-man team will be free)

Rifles/Sights Allowed: "Service Rifle" and "Match Rifle" as defined in the Current CMP Rulebook, Rule 5.1.

Challenges: A challenge fee of \$3.00 will be charged for each unsuccessful challenge made.

Food: Competitors are responsible for their own food and water. There will be no break during the match for lunch.

Awards: The overall match winning team will be awarded the Haerter & Yale Trophy*; presented by ORPA. Additional awards will be given based on participation.

Ammunition: Competitors must supply their own safe ammunition. No incendiary or tracer ammo is permitted.

Course of Fire: Civilian Marksmanship Program President's Rifle Course (see rule 6.3 Table 3), consisting of 30 shots total, 10 offhand at 200 yards, 10 rapid fire prone at 300 yards, and 10 slow fire prone at 600 yards per team member. This will be fired as in the "CMP Cup Match" format (with sighters, and rapid fire starting from position). Sighting shots for slow fire stages will be convertible and pair firing is not required.

Rifle Match Date: Monday, May 26th (PM)

Location: Alliance Rifle Club, 6005 Alliance Rd NW, Malvern OH 44644

Eligibility: This match is open to all qualified shooters 14 years or older. Military personnel may enter if they comply with applicable regulations. Membership in the NRA or a CMP affiliated club is not required.

Entries: Entries must be made in writing in advance. Pre-registration is strongly encouraged to ensure we can provide an adequate number of E-Targets. Participants will sign a CMP eligibility affidavit and liability agreement along with an ARC club liability release.

Range capacity: Range capacity for this match is 24 teams of 2 shooters.

Time to arrive: Front gate will be open at 7:00 AM. Arrive no later than 10:30 AM if only shooting this match.

Registration, **squadding**, **and rifle inspection**: Will take place immediately following the award presentation of the morning match and will last approximately 20 min. at the 300 yard firing line with any final adjustments to be made on the firing line. Up to 2 relays may be squadded.

Time of Firing (PM): Pits seal 45 min after the completion of the AM match. Firing will begin approx. 15 min after the pits seal

Rules: CMP Games 2025 Competition Rulebook (12th Edition) Empty chamber indicators are required.

Fees: Match entry fee: \$30.00/team (A junior 2-man team will be free)

Rifles/Sights Allowed: "Vintage Sniper Rifle" as defined in the current CMP Games Rulebook (Tables 8&9) (Other rifles will be allowed but will compete as "Out-of-Competition")

Challenges: A challenge fee of \$3.00 will be charged for each unsuccessful challenge made.

Food: Competitors are responsible for their own food and water. There will be no break during the match for lunch.

Awards: The winning teams from each rifle category (A/B), as established in CMP Games Rulebook Rule 7.2.1, shall be awarded and recognized. The highest overall scoring team will be awarded the 40 Thieves Trophy*.

Ammunition: Competitors must supply their own safe ammunition. No incendiary or tracer ammo is permitted.

Course of Fire: The course of fire for each team includes one 5 minute sighting period and 20 record shots (each team member fires 10 shots) at 300 yards and 600 yards. The 5 minute sighting periods are for both team members. Each team fires a total of 40 Record shots. **Competitors will be required to bring their own sandbags.**
